Your AC Filter

Did you know that replacing your AC filter is one of the easiest and most effective methods of conserving energy and saving money on your Electric Bill?

Try to make it a point to check your filter at least once a month and replace it as needed, this is especially important during the summer when dust and allergens circulate. If the filter becomes clogged, your system will have to work harder to supply the same amount of cool air resulting in higher energy consumption which will raise your electric bill. Much like changing the oil in your car, changing your AC filter is a critical step in maintaining your systems long term health. Our maintenance team will be in your home once every 3 months to check on your AC, smoke detectors and your fire extinguisher but, you are welcome to stop by the office and grab a filter anytime you need one.
