Keeping cool

There is a possibility that your AC system may be doing all it can do during extreme heat conditions.

Please note that a variable of up to 4 degrees on your thermostat during extreme heat is considered within range. Most HVAC companies state that the systems are considered working normally if they cool 20 degree's from the outside temperature.

- A FEW TIPS TO CONSIDER
- · CRANKING YOUR THERMOSTAT WAY DOWN DOES NOT SPEED UP HOW FAST YOUR HOUSE COOLS.
- · ALL EXTERNAL AND INTERNAL VARIABLES WILL AFFECT THE INDOOR TEMPERATURE.
- · Have you changed your air filters lately? A dirty filter decreases the efficiency of the unit.
- · Every time the entry doors are opened the temperature of the house increases.
- · The sun will heat any object it shines upon and that includes the inside of your home. Close blinds throughout the day.
